- A wide range of vocational courses, including those in literacy and numeracy, are provided in the senior school according to need.
- Courses in Years 11-13, Languages and option subjects in Year 10 are offered only if numbers and staffing are viable.
- Subjects can be taken through e-learning. This allows students to learn through the virtual learning network if it cannot be taken in the usual school timetable.
- Personalised learning programmes are developed for all senior students in collaborating with the student and parents/caregivers.
- Religious Education is a NCEA subject and Levels, 1, 2 and 3 and is compulsory from Year 7 to 13.
