**Code of Conduct**  
(Schedule One)

**International Students, enrolled at St Peter's College will:**

- Follow classroom expectations
- Respect all school staff respectfully in tone and manner
- Interact positively and appropriately with others – zero tolerance of violence, sexual misconduct or bullying
- Be respectful of teaching and learning time
- Be respectful of our community by wearing the uniform neatly and correctly
- Arrive on time, with the correct equipment and ready to learn
- Engage in the tasks the teacher sets, and aim to complete them, including homework
- Meet deadlines for work.
- Regularly attend school (as a condition of your student visa)
- Remain on school grounds during the school hours.
- Abide by New Zealand laws (including wearing a seatbelt while traveling in a vehicle, wearing a helmet while riding a bike, riding bikes on the road)
- Not be involved (either by possession, usage or selling) with drugs, tobacco or alcohol (even if you are 18, as an international student you are NOT allowed to drink alcohol)
- Seek permission from the Director of International Students before you leave Gore for a weekend or holiday (unless it is with your host family).
- Inform the International Student Director of any personal/ school problems, illness or anything else that concerns you so that a plan can be made to support you.
